



### COMMENT ON READINGS

The liturgy of the word of this Sunday draws attention to the new covenant of man with God, which has been concluded in Christ. As the Book of Jeremiah announces, this covenant will be written in the hearts of the People of God.

It is done by Jesus, as emphasized by the author of The Hebrews and the Gospel. The Sacrifice made by the Son of God is a spring of the grace of salvation for all of us.

### PASTORAL MESSAGES

1. The call to conversion encourages the constant discovery of the beauty and depth of the Eucharist. In Lent, this path leads to the source of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. As we approach Easter, we enter a time of more intense reflection on the suffering of our Lord.

2. We remind you that the year dedicated to St. Joseph continues in the Church. We encourage you to pray to the caregiver of the Holy Family, and let us recommend to him the affairs of our families.

3. On Thursday, March 25, the Celebration of the Annunciation – exactly nine months before Christmas. It is the Day of Holiness of Life. Let us support with prayer those who fight to defend life from conception to natural death.

4. On all Thursdays (in English) and Fridays (in Polish) of Lent, we contemplate the torment of the Lord Jesus on the Way of the Cross at 19:00.

5. Let us all remember to keep a sanitary protocol in the space of our church, namely: masks, disinfection of hands and keeping a distance.

6. We wish all those celebrating their birthdays and anniversaries this week an abundance of God's graces and the care of the Blessed Mother for every day. Have a nice and blessed Sunday.

7. Due to the pandemic, sanitary regulations also apply in our parish. We remind you that during Holy Week and Easter holidays, parishioners who have previously ordered and received tickets can attend services. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.
