THE POPE PASTORAL WORKS - MAY 16

This collection provides an opportunity for Catholics to make a financial offering to assist the Holy Father. One-third of the funds collected is for what is traditionally known as Peter's Pence: donations used by the Pope for his charitable contributions to those most in need throughout the world, as well as for the support of the Holy See and its activities. Twothirds of the Collection for the Pope's Pastoral Works is to support the Holy Father in administering the Holy See and how Peter's Pence is used, as well as donations in response to Canon 1271, is available in the Holy See's yearly financial report. "Each individual Christian and every community is called to be an instrument of God for the liberation and promotion of the poor, and for enabling them to be fully a part of society. This demands that we be docile and attentive to the cry of the world's goods, and sees a brother or sister in need and yet refuses help?' (1 Jn 3.17)."

WORLD COMMUNICATION DAY - MAY 16

Today Catholics are invited to reflect upon the media of social communication (film, radio, television, newspaper, and audiovisuals) and how these influence our lives. The media can promote values that lead to a more fully human society. The Church's ministry is twofold. The media can be used to help promote the Gospel. At the same time, as receivers of the materials presented by the media, the faithful have a duty to support and promote worthwhile presentations on media and reject those which promote values contrary to spiritual growth.
