FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT-NOVEMBER 29TH

The Word of God this Sunday urges us to be vigilant, to turn our lives to God.

The words of the Book of Isaiah and the Book of Psalms guide us in the prayer of the heart that calls on the Lord right now, eagerly thirsting for his grace. On the other hand, Saint Paul reminds the Corinthians and us that we have received great God's grace in Christ, so let us look at Him. Receiving grace does not make it work automatically. You have to look for it carefully, and it will be easier if we keep watch. Let the word of God guide us through our "now." That we would discover God's gift in us - the immensity of the gift that each of us has received.

PASTORAL MESSAGES

1. Today we begin the season of Advent which will prepare us for the feast of Christmas. During this special time of waiting, Mary accompanies us. She was the first to respond to God with a fiat and accepted His plan. We want, looking at her example, to follow her.
2. Advent is a time of special work on oneself. We encourage you to make personal sacrifices, put your affairs in order, stop and reflect more deeply on your behavior and relationships. Let us remember about confession on these days of waiting for the coming of the Lord.
3. This week will be the first Thursday of December. We wish to pray for new, holy and numerous vocations to God's service. Let us embrace with our prayers all the priests, religious and consecrated persons known to us, whose witness of life and love for God and neighbor is a clear sign for us. In the universal Church, we are celebrating the Missionary Day of the Pontifical Missionary Union. Let us remember the clergy and lay missionaries, let us support them spiritually and materially, and let us ask for new vocations, so that the preachers of the Good News will never be lacking.
4. On Friday, December 4th, it will be the first Friday of the month. It is an occasion for a special prayer in reward to the Sacred Heart of Jesus for personal and world sins. We remind you that on this day in our parish church we have the opportunity to adore the Eucharistic Jesus after the morning Holy Mass until the evening, and then also throughout the night. In the morning, the Pastor will visit the sick parishioners. Let us make sure that on this day our relatives can receive the sacrament of penance and reconciliation and Holy

Communion. Please call the office if you would like a visit by the priest.

5. We wish all the birthday and anniversary celebrations of this week an abundance of God's favors and the protection of the Holy Mother on each day.

6. This week's saints patrons are:

- on Monday, November 30 - St. Andrew the Apostle, brother of Simon Peter, belonged to the closest group of the Lord Jesus;
- on Thursday, December 3 - St. Franciszek Ksawery (1506-1552), priest, Jesuit, one of the greatest missionaries in the history of the Church;
- on Friday, December 4 - St. Barbara (3rd / 4th century), virgin and martyr, patron saint of miners and steel workers and the unemployed.
