SERVING THE LORD

Only by sacrifice, by sacrifice made into an enduring frame of mind, can we do the will of the Father in heaven. Only by entering into Christ's sacrifice at Holy Mass can we bring forth fruits of holiness. Whether we are laymen, priests or religious as Christians we have but one vocation: to bring to maturity the divine Life we have received at Baptism, that is, to identify ourselves more and more with Christ, to become vitally living branches on Him, the true Vine. The real test of holiness, of our fidelity to God's will, is our willingness to spend ourselves, our time, our love, our effort, in the apostolate. It takes more than one or two trees to make an orchard. God wills not only healthy trees, but more and more healthy trees. We are his instruments in bringing about that ideal. Our personal holiness will not only draw others (that is the way holiness acts), it will compel us to see our whole life in terms of Christ's world vision of salvation and sanctification. Some day the Owner of the garden is going to make a tour of inspection. "By their fruits you will know them," He will say to Himself. We ought to be very much concerned about the results of that inspection. Will we stand the test of his appraising glance from the standpoint of our personal holiness as well as of the effort we have put into the apostolate? Or will we have to shudder at his verdict: "Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire?"
